



## Aida Luz Milligan

September 4, 1937 - March 26, 2019

Funeral services to honor and celebrate the life of Aida Luz Milligan will be held at 10:00 A.M. Friday, March 29, 2019 at the First United Methodist Church in Tishomingo, Oklahoma. Interment to follow at Hinton Cemetery in Hinton, Oklahoma.

Aida Luz Ayala-Vega Milligan was born September 4th, 1937 in Toa Alta, Puerto Rico to Jose and Dolores Ayala-Vega. She entered the heavenly gate and took the Blessed Virgin Mary by the hand on March 26, 2019, in Tishomingo, OK. Her family lived in Toa Alta where she grew up and attended school. After graduating high school, she moved with her sister Carmen to Weatherford, Oklahoma in 1957. Soon after, she met and married Larry Milligan of Hinton, Oklahoma. They were married on June 23rd, 1958. They made their home in Hinton where their two sons were born; Jeff in April of 1959 and Aaron in April of 1961. Soon after, the family moved to Lawton, OK where Larry took a teaching position. Aida busied herself raising their two boys and was an avid bowler in the local leagues. In 1965, the family moved to Tishomingo OK. She worked many different jobs, but spent most of her working life caring for others as a nursing assistant and physical therapy tech at Johnston County Memorial Hospital and as a counselor at Counseling Inc. in Tishomingo. She had a passion for animals, breeding and showing pure-bred dachshunds and volunteering countless hours at the local animal shelter and spay and neuter clinics throughout the area. She cared for every stray

dog or cat that found its way to her door and fattened every raccoon in the area with scraps from her table.

She was a caring and generous friend to many in the community and to many migrant farm workers over the years who welcomed the support and comfort of a Spanish-speaking abuela. She dearly loved her husband, her sons and daughters-in-law, her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She will be sorely missed.

She was preceded in death by her parents, and siblings; brothers Jose Luis and Orlando and sisters Carmen, Doris, Mirna and Gladys. She is survived by her husband Larry, her sons, Jeff and wife Nennette of Tallahassee, FL, Aaron and wife Erin of Norman, OK, brothers Ruben Ayala-Vega of Babenhausen, Germany and Ramon Ayala-Vega of Orlando, FL, brother and sister-in-law Dean and Yvonne Donaldson of Irving, Texas, grandchildren Shawn Milligan and wife Brandi, Zac Milligan, Ismael Milligan, Claire Milligan, Gabriel Milligan and great-grandchildren Paxton and Cruz.

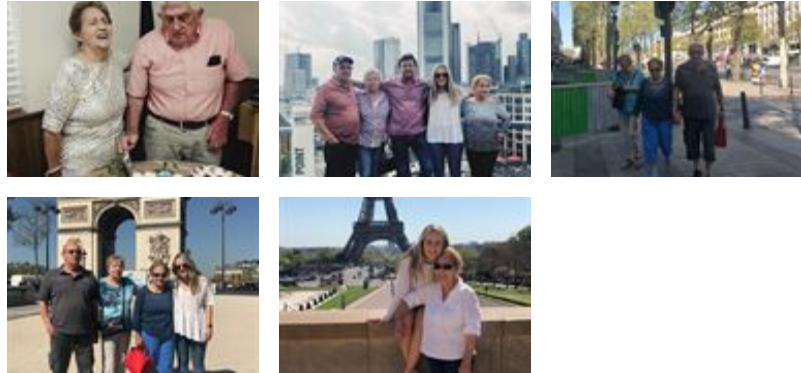
