Alice Joy Douthit, a resident of Newcastle, OK was born on December 12, 1918 in Foster, OK to Ida Mae (Huffman) and William Monroe Littrell, she passed away on December 22, 2012 at the age of 94 years and 10 days. After high school Mrs. Douthit attended East Central State College in Ada, OK where she graduated with a degree in education, upon graduation she returned to begin her teaching career at Burrows High School in Foster, OK in 1938. She then went on to achieve her Master's in Education from the University of Oklahoma, as well as, her certificate of special education from the University of Oklahoma. After her time at East Central Alice married Hubert M. Douthit at Foster, OK on January 29, 1943. Mrs. Douthit was a Baptist who spent most of her life in the Wynnewood area. She was preceded in death by her husband Hubert in 1988, also four brothers.

She is survived by a Son and Daughter in law – Duane H. and Karen Douthit of Mustang, OK; Daughter and Son in law – Twila and Paul House of Newcastle, OK; 6 Grandchildren – Stephanie Campbell, Angela Gobble, Jared Douthit, Dawn Robbins, Tonya Bernard, and Anja Boettcher; 9 Great Grandchildren.
