Nina went to her Heavenly home to be with Jesus on February 20, 2018, from her home on Earth at Vanoss. Nina was born December 12, 1921, in Yantis, Texas, to Rachel Dora Crawford Boyd and William Joseph Boyd. The family later moved to the Hart, Oklahoma area, where Nina attended school. She married Rimmel B. Tiffin on December 12, 1936, on her fifteenth birthday. Rimmel and Nina moved to Grand Prairie, Texas in 1941, where they both worked for North American Aviation, Inc., until 1945. Nina was one of the original "Rosie the Riveters" of World War II. They moved to Hagerstown, Md., in 1945, but "It was cold, we couldn't find a decent place to live, and the pay wasn't as good as it was at North American." So they packed up and moved back to Oklahoma where Nina worked alongside her husband in operating a ranch and dairy farm until retirement. Nina loved gardening, sewing, cooking and making quilts for her grandchildren. Her pecan pies never failed to win blue ribbons at the county fair. She was a member of the Vanoss Home and

Community Education Club for more than fifty years. She was a member of the Lightning Ridge Baptist Church, where she sang in the choir as long as she could.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Joe and Rachel Boyd; her husband Remmel; and three brothers, Joe Bailey Boyd, William Kenneth Boyd, and Billy Joe Boyd, and one great-great grandson Kaden Byrd. She is survived by three sisters, Vernice Mann of Terrell, TX; Mildred Kent of Tucson, AZ; and Floy Harris of Vaca Ville, CA; one daughter, Patricia Peay of Ada; and one son, Michael Tiffin and wife Shari of Vanoss; grandchildren Trina Stark and husband David, Shannon Hooks, Kari Eldred, Dusty Bolin,
