Funeral Services for Mrs. Auda Lee Payne, 91, of Wapanucka, Oklahoma will be held on Tuesday, May 31st, 2011 at 11:00 a. m. in the First Baptist Church of Wapanucka with Rev. Neal Alford officiating. Interment will follow in the Rose Hill Cemetery. Mrs. Payne passed away on May 25th, at the Oklahoma Heart Hospital in Oklahoma City.

Auda Lee was born on October 9th, 1919 to Joseph L. Orr and Ollie Mae (Gibson) Orr. She was raised in the Calvin-Atwood, Oklahoma area in Hughes County and graduated from Atwood High School in 1939.
