### Bernice Jackson Obituary

Bernice Jackson passed away on August 11, 2015 at the age of 100. She was born the 8th of March, 1915 in Parker, TX (Johnson County), the 2nd child of John and Lela Williams. Preceded in death by her parents, husband Edward Allan Jackson (1998), brother Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court Judge Ben T. Williams & wife Ruth, sister Hollie Mae Cook & husband Don.
