Berta Sue Bulman, a resident of Mill Creek was born August 19, 1939 in Nash, Oklahoma to Charles and Lois (Hardiman) Nelson. She passed away Saturday March 23, 2013 at Midwest City, Oklahoma at the age of 73 years 7 months and 4 days. Berta grew up in Nash graduating from Nash High School. She then obtained her Bachelors degree from OSU and her Masters idegree in education from ECU. Berta and John G. Bulman were married on March 30, 1963 at Nash, Oklahoma.
