He lived in Allen, and came to Sulphur where he worked for the CC.corp in building Platt National Park. He worked for Jack Nowlin Clothiers several years. He married Mildred Stephens on February 9, 1935 at Sulphur. They moved to Chicago for few years moving back to Sulphur in 1954. They owned and operated Heaths Sulphur Greenhouse and Florist. He served as Secretary of the Murray County Election Board several years. He was a former member of the Elks Lodge and had been active in politics. He was a member of the Sulphur United Methodist Church.

He was preceded in death by his wife Mildred April 21, 1999, a son Bill E. Heath II in 1996. and a great grandson.
