Bill Fulton, a resident of Sulphur was born March 19, 1920 in Jackson, Tennessee to Carrie A (Berridge) and William L. Fulton. He passed away Thursday October 30, 2008 at Ardmore, Ok at the age of 88 years 7 months and 11 days. Bill grew up in the Sulphur area attending Sulphur schools and graduating from Sulphur High School in 1938. He served in the Air Force while in the military. Bill graduated from O.U. Law school in 1950 and he and Edith S. Adams were married on Aug. 21, 1953 in Okmulgee, Ok where he served as assistant district attorney. He also worked as an insurance adjuster for State Farm Insurance and was elected for three terms as judge in Murray County. Bill also assisted his brother in the furniture business. He is preceded in death by his parents; a son: Clint C. Fulton; and by a brother: J.T. Fulton. Bill was a longtime member of the First Christian Church.
