Billy Charuth Brewer of Sulphur, Oklahoma passed away peacefully on January 18, 2019. The second of 8 children, he was born February 1, 1932 on the Wagley Ranch, near Friona, Texas to Luther James and Dellora Land Brewer. Billy married Wanda June Ivey on December 20, 1952 and together raised 5 sons: Steve, Clay, Layne, Coley and Luis.

Billy accomplished many things in his life. He was instrumental in development of antilock braking systems and missile defense while serving as an Engineering Technician for the University of New Mexico. He along with June later owned and operated Brewer's TV and Appliance in Sulphur for 22 years until his retirement.

Most important was the value he placed in God, country, and family. He proudly served his country in both the U.S. Navy and Army during the Korean conflict. There were no gray areas in what he believed. First and foremost, he believed that there was only one way to heaven and that was through Jesus Christ. He delivered that message of promise and hope to countless people throughout his life. He and June were members of Crossway Baptist Church since 1974, where he served as a deacon and Sunday school teacher of the "Young Couples" class.

He had an old-school work ethic and taught his sons that they could accomplish anything through hard work. He was a true leader in all aspects of his life and believed in doing things right or not at all. He led by example and expected no less of his sons, particularly when it came to leading a Christian

home. He gave everything he had to his family and believed in his sons although they often didn't deserve it. While many spend their lives building bank accounts, Billy Brewer spent his building a Christian legacy that is reflected in the generations he left behind.

Billy is survived by his 5 sons and daughters-in-law: Steve and Carol, Bernalillo, NM, Clay and Helen, Placid, TX, Layne and Laura, Valley View, TX, Coley and Andra, Davis, OK, and Luis and Gayla Barreras, Durant, OK. He is also survived by 9 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren, His brothers Bobby Brewer and wife Carolyn, and Sammy Brewer, and numerous nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his wife, parents, 1 brother, 4 sisters, and daughter-in-law Kelly Brewer.

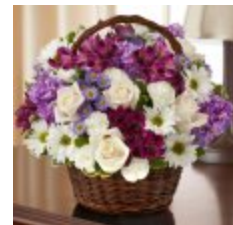
