



Billy G. 'Bill' Ramey

Funeral Services Billy G. "Bill" Ramey, 83, of Ravia, Oklahoma will be held on Saturday, March 10, 2018 at 2:00 p. m. in the Ravia Baptist Church with Pastor Jonathan Smith officiating. Interment will follow in the Condon Grove Cemetery in Milburn, Oklahoma. Military Honors will be provided by the Patriot Guard Riders while in procession and by The Chickasaw Nation Honor Guard at the cemetery. Mr. Ramey passed away on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 at the Veteran's Medical Center in Oklahoma City.

Billy was born on September 29, 1934 in Bromide, Oklahoma to Joe Monford Ramey and Myrtle (Schultz) Ramey. He grew up in the Bromide area and graduated from Prairie View School. After graduation, he served in the United States Navy as a Seaman on board the USS Mathews during the Korean Conflict. After his discharge, he was a fireman in El Paso, Texas, and married Lois Meyer on September 29, 1980 in Port Lavaca, Texas. Bill spent most of his working life in the Auto Paint and Body business, retiring in 1997 after a kidney transplant. He was also a dirt track race car driver. Bill gave his life to the Lord on October 24, 2004 and attended the Ravia Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a son, Mike Babb; two brothers and three sisters.

Bill is survived by his wife Lois, of the home; three sons, Alan Babb of Norman, Oklahoma, Ty Eason and Darrin Kucera, both of Tishomingo; two daughters, Lynn Ramey of Enis, Oklahoma and Charlene Ballard of Tishomingo; his sister, Delores Gordon of Tishomingo; two brothers, Doug

Ramey of Carson City, Nevada and Danny Ramey of Quincey, California; nine grandchildren; eleven great-grandchildren; and other relatives.
