Funeral Services for Mr. Billy Jr. Huckleby, 80, of Milburn, Oklahoma will be held on Wednesday, August 8th, 2012 at 1:00 p. m. at the First Baptist Church of Milburn with Rev. Steve Hogue officiating. Interment will follow in the Condon Grove Cemetery. Mr. Huckleby passed away on August 4th, 2012 at his home.
