Starting her days at 5 AM and evenings checking cattle if needed she would work on her dining table with a manual adding machine never missing an Asher baseball or basketball game of her son Jerry or grandsons, DeWayne, and Darin or great-grandkids. Adding to her works she'd cook a good size country dinner every Sunday. Usually had extra young people there and was always welcoming, everyone knew her as grandma Cat! Catherine loved to travel she and her late husband Elbert visiting all U.S. States and many abroad South America, Hawaii, and Europe. After the passing of her husband, she began to travel with her sister-in-law

Roxie. Catherine drove them to Niagara Falls, New York, and California. She enjoyed and lived a remarkable life. She will be missed RIP.
