Eddie was born on July 19th, 1933 in Bowlegs, Oklahoma to Walter Edgar Springs and Mary Astor (Shell) Springs. He grew up in Bowlegs and graduated from high school there. Later, he attended and graduated from Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, Oklahoma with a BA degree in Business Administration and a BA degree in Psychology.
