Charles Ernest McNeil, a resident of Sulphur, was born April 12, 1928 in Seminole, Oklahoma, to Charlie E. & Mary (Ridenour) McNeil. He passed away Monday, May 03, 2004 at Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 76 years. He was married to Mary Jane (Moffatt) McNeil at Durant, Oklahoma in 1944. He grew up in Atoka. He was a graduate of Oklahoma Baptist University in Shawnee, Oklahoma, and attended Southwestern Theological Seminary in Ft Worth, Texas. He pastored several churches in eastern Oklahoma including Talihina First Baptist, Stigler Main Street, Kinta First Baptist, and Council Hill. He helped establish two churches, Black Jack Baptist in Atoka County, and Buffalo Valley Baptist in LeFlore County. Mr. McNeil lived in Sulphur several years where he owned & operated Star Hardware & Furniture. What began as a hobby in woodworking, took him to a new business in cabinet and furniture making in Ardmore for 25 years. He retired in 2002 and moved back to Sulphur in 2003. He was a member of First Baptist Church. Mr. McNeil was preceded in death by his parents; 2 sisters, Jean Lassiter & Norma Ridgeway.
