Cletues Harold Dixon was born on January 18, 1947 to Jackie “Dib” Dixon Sr. & Artie Aleta (White) Dixon. He passed from this life on Wednesday, February 18, 2026 in his home east of Wynnewood. He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Maudeane “Dena” White.

After being Honorably Discharged for services rendered to his country Cletues returned home to Wynnewood, where he became Postmaster and ran the Wynnewood Post Office for many years until his retirement there. He then went on to open Dixon Variety, which he and his wife owned and operated for nearly 40 years until its closing.

Cletues was a man of community, wearing many hats around town over the course of his life. He loved spending time with his family & friends, taking care of his farm and spending time in church. He will be deeply missed by all who

knew and loved him.
