Funeral Services for Mr. Council Holt, 88, of Connerville, Oklahoma will be held on Saturday, March 10th, 2012 at 2:00 p. m. at the First Baptist Church in Connerville with Pastor Loren Harper officiating. Interment will follow in the Connerville Cemetery. Mr. Holt passed away on March 8th, at the Mercy Hospital in Tishomingo, Oklahoma.

Council was born on October 23rd, 1923 in Connerville to William Hampton Holt and Ada (Harper) Holt. He attended school in Connerville and graduated from Pontotoc High School.
