Memorial Services for Mr. David Charles Hornsby, 74, of Shawnee, Oklahoma will be held on Tuesday, August 21st, 2012 at 2:00 p. m. in the First Baptist Church of Coleman, Oklahoma. A private burial will be held at a later date. Mr. Hornsby passed away on August 18th, 2012 at the Integris Baptist Medical Center in Oklahoma City.
