There was never a dull moment with 7 children and in laws and grandchildren. At times everyone talking and nobody listening

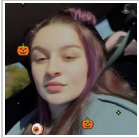

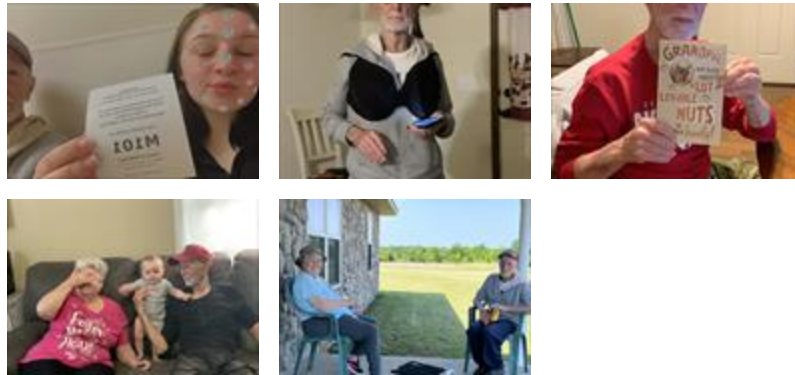

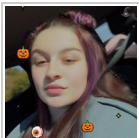
