DeLois (Dee) Allen Fry, of Ravia, Oklahoma passed away peacefully on Sunday, June 23, 2024, at the age of 90. She was born on March 13, 1934 at home just North of Mannsville near the Norton Bridge, to Percilla Ann (Williford) and Dillard Lee Coffman. Dee was better known as Bunch to her many friends. She loved her friends and family dearly, but there was no secret to her love for animals and working hands. She grew up in the Norton Bend area and attended both Mannsville and Dickson schools before graduating from Russett in 1952.
