His granddaughter Kenya said that he would read the Farmer’s Almanac and tell her exactly what to do when it came to raising babies and boy was it accurate, she said. A real dinner, not for Delton, he preferred the sweets over anything. Visiting with people and spending time with his family is what he

enjoyed doing most of all and he will be forever missed.

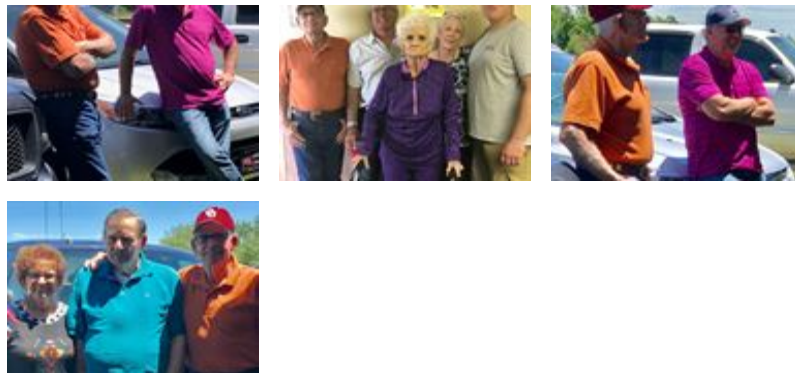

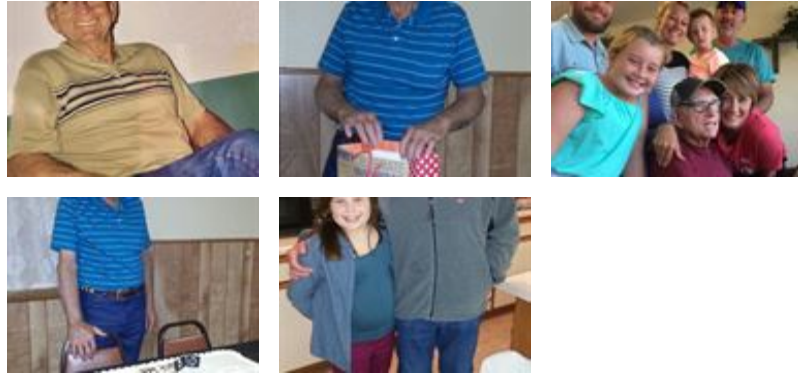
