Jasper Don Petitti was born in McAlester to Isadora & Domenica (Quilico) Petitti. He grew up in McAlester, where he graduated from High School. He attended Kent University in Ohio, before joining the Navy where he was a Signalman 2nd class during WWII. He came to Sulphur in 1948. He married Jamie Sue Lattimore on January 13, 1950 at Ada. He was the owner & operator of the OTASCO store in Sulphur until his retirement in 1989. He was a member of St. Francis Catholic Church, Erchaustic Minister, Sacristan, Pres. of the priest parish council. He was a fourth degree in the Knights of Columbus. He was a member of Kiwanis where he served as president, Lt. Governor, & District Governor of the Texas-Okla. District. He was past president of the Chamber of Commerce. Charter member of BPOE, Life member of American Legion, DAV & VFW.

He was preceded in death by a daughter Donna Sue Ables, and a sister: Ann Jackson.
