Funeral Services for Donald E. O'Dell, 72, of Oklahoma City will be held on Saturday, January 30, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. in the Clark Funeral Chapel with Mr. Buddy Parks officiating. (originally planned for 3:00 pm Friday, January 29th, rescheduled to due inclement weather. Interment will follow in the Tishomingo Cemetery. Mr. O'Dell passed away on Sunday, January 24th, in a Midwest City Hospital.

Donald was born on December 16, 1937 in Pilot Point, Texas to Fay O'Dell and Beatrice Davis O'Dell. He attended Nida Schools and later Murray State College. Don taught school for 32 plus years in different parts of the country and was also a coach, insurance salesman and had worked for the Department of Human Services.
