Dorothy Floy Dunn was born February 22, 1923 to Pearl and Hollis Underwood in Elmore City, Oklahoma. Her siblings included sisters Francis and Averene and brother Buddy. Dorothy started school in Elmore City and when the family moved to Wynnewood, this was her forever home, she would never wish to live anywhere else.

She was married to Terrell Zane Dunn on May 27, 1944. She was proud to brag that they had been married over 75 years. The love of her life passed away suddenly on September 27, 2019. She tried to adapt to many changes in a very short time. She missed him terribly.

Dorothy worked at the First National Bank from 1954 until she retired in 1989. She enjoyed each day visiting and helping bank patrons, who were first of all her friends. Halloween and Christmas were celebrated at the bank with punch and cookies and with Dorothy dressed up as a clown for Halloween and Mrs. Santa at Christmas. She continued wearing her costumes every year through her stay at the Willows where she turned 97.

Her health began to fail the next year and she had several falls and trips to hospitals. Her main goal through her illnesses and the COVID isolation was looking forward to when she could walk back into her church.

Dorothy moved into Burford Manor April 2021, following a bad fall and hospitalization. She loved the nurses who cared for and were so kind to her there.

She was a member of the Wynnewood First Methodist for over 75 years and especially in their later years this was a central part of Dorothy and Terrells life's. She especially enjoyed visiting the elderly, taking them candy and treats in little ceramic baskets she had painted. When she was no longer able to do visits or other things for the church, she took on the special task of making sure to have a get well card for church members to sign, when any member of the congregation was ill. She loved making brownies for friends who were ill and for the church monthly dinners. If you ever did her a favor, you were sure to receive her special brownies or a pie as a thank you.

Dorothy is survived by her sister Francis Whatley; children, Jim Dunn and wife Linda, Connie Clock and husband Jim; grandchildren, Cindy Dierks, Carol Clock Goetz, Craig Dunn, Bret Dunn, Tana Hardy, Brooke Stewart; 10 great grandchildren and many, many other family and friends.
