January 22, 1917 - December 11, 2010

Dorothy Esther Westberg Burns, a resident of Norman, OK was born January 22, 1917 in Chicago, Illinois to Amanda Marie (Carlson) and Karl Emil Westberg. She passed away December 11, 2010 at Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 93 years 10 months and 19 days. She married Frank Brent Burns in Chicago, IL on November 3, 1944. Dorothy grew up in Chicago where she lived until 1948. After graduating from Carl Schurz High School in 1935, she attended Chicago Normal College for three years. She then enrolled in the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana and graduated in 1939 with a degree in Education. She taught in the Chicago school system until the birth of their first child. She then became a fulltime homemaker and devoted mother.

In 1948, the family moved to St. Paul, MN, and then, in 1949, moved to Wynnewood, OK, where they made their permanent home. In 2007, Dorothy moved to Norman, OK, to be closer to family. She was preceded in death by her Husband - Frank Brent Burns on January 17, 1988; an infant daughter in 1959; four Brothers - Lawrence, Viv, Oliver, and Vernon Westberg; four Sisters - Lucile Norlin, Emily Fouts, Ruth Vallandigham, and Grace Nameny; Grandson - Gregory F. 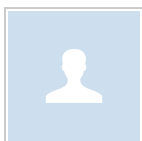
