



Dorothy Camp Kincaid

April 20, 1924 - January 6, 2013

Dorothy Camp Kincaid of Wynnewood, Oklahoma, was born on April 20, 1924, in Honey Grove, Texas, to Ruby Mae (Blanton) and Ben Winkler. She died on January 6, 2013 at the age of 88.

Dorothy's mother died in 1925. She and her older sister Helen Ruth were reared by their widowed grandmother, Martha (Cook) Winkler on the family farm in Ravenna, Texas.

During WW II Dorothy at the age of 18 contributed to the war effort by working for Convair Aircraft in Fort Worth. It was in Fort Worth that she met and married Albert Dale Camp. After the war they moved to Odessa, Texas where they raised their only child Roger Dale. Dorothy moved to Euless, Texas in 1967, where she worked as a medical records clerk and in 1981 she married Bud Kincaid, Jr. In 1988 Bud and Dorothy moved to Wynnewood Oklahoma to be near her son.

Dorothy was preceded in death by Roger's dad, A.D. Camp in 1996 and Bud Kincaid in 2003, her step mother Virgie Kight Winkler, her older brother John William Winkler and two half brothers, Harold Lee and Robert Wayne Winkler. She is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Roger Dale and Ava Jo Camp of Wynnewood, a granddaughter, Jennifer Camp Sparks, and two great grandsons Cole and Beau Sparks of Norman, Oklahoma. She is also survived by her much beloved sister Helen Ruth Hasten of Springfield, Virginia, half-brother Donald Gene Winkler of Bonham, Texas and three half sisters,

Elizabeth Sue Jewett of Springtown, Texas; Linda Kay Cross of Grand Prairie, Texas and Glenda Fay Ross of Bedford, Texas along with a number of nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, January 10, 2013 at 1:00 PM at Cedarlawn Memorial Park in Sherman, Texas. Services are under the direction of DeArman Funeral Home of Wynnewood, OK.
