Her most recent employment was to work for the Chickasaw Telephone Company for numerous years as a telephone operator and more recently as a substitute teacher and tutor for the Davis School System.

At the age of twelve years Dorothy surrendered her life to Jesus Christ when she became a born-again Christian. Proudly she would tell everyone she was proud to be a Christian and that she would go to live with Jesus when she died, Her fondest desire was to die in her chair in her home, but her declining health prevented it from happening.
