Funeral Services for Ed "Poodle" Jones, Jr. will be held on Tuesday, March 16th, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at the Clark Funeral Chapel with Rev. J. D. Leavelle officiating. Burial was at Rose Hill Cemetery in Wapanucka, Oklahoma. A lifelong teacher and educator, and WWII veteran, Ed passed away at home on March 11th, 2010.

He was born in Atoka County on December 14th, 1925, the son of H. E. Jones and Alma Casey Jones. He was retired from teaching in Boggy Depot, Coalgate, Clarita in Oklahoma, Gallup and Crownpoint, New Mexico and returned to his family home in 1982.
