Memorial Graveside Services for Mr. Edward W. Kendall, 81, of Wapanucka, Oklahoma will be held on Saturday, April 30th, 2011 at 1:00 p. m. at the Rose Hill Cemetery in Wapanucka with Rev. Neal Alford officiating. Mr. Kendall passed away on April 26th, at the Oklahoma Veterans Center in Sulphur, Oklahoma.
