



Eugene Fuzz Kennedy

July 18, 1937 - February 10, 2016

Eugene "Fuzz" Kennedy, a resident of Sulphur was born July 18, 1937 in Sulphur, Oklahoma to Joseph Lewis & Iva Belle (Tallant) Kennedy. He passed away Wednesday February 10, 2016 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 78 years 6 months and 22 days.

He was married to Rene Ann (Baker) Kennedy at Sulphur on May 25, 1957. He had lived most of his life in the Sulphur area, graduated from Sulphur High School. Fuzz retired from the National Park Service in 1994. He was an Honorary Member of the Sulphur Kiwanis Club, Volunteer Fireman for 15 years. He had served in the US Army for 5 years.

Fuzz helped run the time clock for the Sulphur Bulldogs Sports program for 26 years. He was a member of the Murray County Cattlemen's Assn. Fuzz was an active member and Deacon of the Crossway Baptist Church. He was a faithful donor the the blood bank. Fuzz was an avid fisherman and enjoyed ranching. He was preceded in death by his parents.

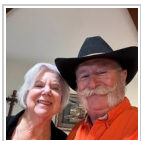

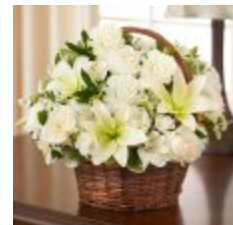
