Funeral Services for Mrs. Floy Jean Moore, 71, of Milburn, Oklahoma will be held on Tuesday, March 6th, 2012 at 10:00 a. m. at the Church of the Nazarene in Fillmore, Oklahoma with Rev. Eugene Ledford officiating. Interment will follow in the Fillmore Cemetery. Mrs. Moore passed away on March 2nd, at the Mercy Hospital in Tishomingo.

Floy Jean was born on August 10th, 1940 in Fillmore to Floyd Odell Scribner and Melissa Emmaline (James) Scribner. She attended Fillmore Schools and later graduated from Milburn High School. She married Glenn M. Moore on December 24th, 1958 in Fillmore and was a lifelong resident of Johnston County.
