Funeral Services for Mr. Floyd S. Cranmore, “the Honey Man”, 83, of the Fillmore Community, will be held on Friday, May 4, 2018 at 2:00 p. m. in the Herb Clark Memorial Chapel at Tishomingo, Oklahoma.
