Forrest McMurtry was born to Marshall & Mable L. (Simmons) McMurtry in Clinton, OK. He died August 11 at Sulphur, Ok. He grew up in Clinton and moved to Sulphur in 1927. He graduated from Sulphur High School in 1930. He worked for Swift Co. for 34 years. He was Murray County Clerk from 1970 to 1980. He served in the Army during WWII and retired in 1962 after 22 years as a Lt. Col. He was a fireman for Sulphur from 1936 to 1956. He married Lois Bullett in 1944. She preceded him in death in 1970. He later married Vivian Shepard Hill Russell. He was a member of Calvary Baptist Church, The Masonic Lodge, Sulphur Lions Club. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother Ewing McMurtry.
