Frank William James, a resident of Wynnewood, was born February 19, 1953 in McAlester, Oklahoma, to Wallace James and Rozella (Palmer) James. He passed away November 30, 2010, at Pauls Valley, Oklahoma, at the age of 57 years 9 months and 11 days. He was married to Kay Karen Kennedy at Edmond, Oklahoma, on April 23, 1983. He was reared on the family ranch outside Haileyville, OK where he graduated High School. He then went on to Panhandle State University where he graduated with a degree in accounting. After graduation he attended Oklahoma City University where he received his Juris Doctor degree. Upon graduation from law school he opened a private practice in OKC. He moved his practice to Wynnewood in 1990 where he practiced law, farmed, and ranched. He was a founding Member of the Hartshorne Methodist Church, and an associate member of the Wynnewood and Paoli Methodist Churches. His other memberships include Wynnewood Chamber of Commerce, Wynnewood Kiwanis, Wynnewood Academics for Excellence, Wynnewood Ambulance Service Board, Oklahoma Bar Association, and Garvin County Bar Association. Mr. James served as District Chairman for the Washita District of Boy Scouts, and served in leadership roles in his church and community. He was also a proud member of the Choctaw Nation.
