George Homer Payne, a resident of Garland, TX was born September 18, 1912 in Stratford, Oklahoma to Grace Elizabeth (Brush) and George Preston Payne. He passed away February 22, 2010 at the age of 97 years 5 months and 4 days. He was married to Effie Geneva Tate Payne at Ada, Oklahoma on June 30, 1940.
