Gladys E. McGaugh, a resident of Sulphur was born August 8, 1928 in Sadler , Texas to Arthur H. and Ella Marie (Kuntz) McGaugh. She passed away Sunday March 7, 2010 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 81 years 6 months and 29 days. Gladys moved to the Sulphur area in 1939 and graduated from S.H.S. in 1945 at age 16. She served in the Navy during the Korean Conflict and worked for the federal government as a medical transcriptionist; working at Ft. Smith, San Antonio, and Tinker Air Force Base.
