



Hollis Truman Rainey

November 11, 1913 - January 11, 2013

Funeral Services for Mr. Hollis Truman Rainey, 99, of Tishomingo, Oklahoma will be held on Tuesday, January 15th, 2013 at 2:00 p. m. in the Calvary Baptist Church with Dr. Rex Clayton officiating. Interment will follow in the Troy Cemetery. Mr. Rainey passed away on January 11th, 2013 at the Mercy Hospital in Tishomingo.

Hollis was born on November 11th, 1913 in Shamrock, Texas to Asa Rainey and Maggie Mae (Conner) Rainey. He grew up there and graduated from Shamrock High School. He married Estelle Preuit on April 23rd, 1938 in Wellington, Texas and they would have celebrated 75 years of marriage in April of 2013. Mr. Rainey came to Oklahoma in 1963, living near Antlers, Oklahoma and moved to Johnston County in 1999. He had worked as a barber and rancher all of his life. Mr. Rainey was an accomplished harmonica player, an artist and loved music, mostly the older gospel songs. He and his wife were members of the Calvary Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Selba and John Rainey and a sister, Pauline Morris.

Mr. Rainey is survived by his wife Estelle, his son and daughter-in-law, Ron and Pamela Rainey of Carrollton, Texas; his daughter, Sondra Hartsell of Tishomingo; two sisters, Cleoma Moody of Bull Head City, Arizona and Marie
