Hubert D. "Red" Robinson, a resident of Sulphur was born June 4, 1937 in Snyder, Oklahoma to Ezekiel & Essie (Hargrove) Robinson. He passed away Sunday April 2, 2017 at Oklahoma City, OK at the age of 79 years 9 months and 28 days. Red attended schools in Snyder, Mountain View and Chickasha, OK. He joined the U S Air Force in May 1955. He became a cook and worked in many aircraft warning units, flight line kitchens and dining halls. He had many assignments outside the United States, including Japan, Viet Nam, Libya and Turkey.
