Memorial Services for Mr. J. C. Mr. Dean passed away on September 12th, at the University Village in Tulsa.

J. C. was born on January 23rd, 1931 in Trinidad, Texas to Dennis James Dean and Mary Jane Dean. He was the oldest of five children. He attended grade school in Folsom, Oklahoma and graduated from Coleman High School in 1948. After, he attended Murray State College in Tishomingo. J. C. served in the United States Marine Corp from 1952 until 1954. He received a Purple Heart during his service and was Honorably Discharged. Sports were a passion and baseball and golf his favorites.
