He later served in the United States Army during WWII from 1944 until 1946, receiving an Honorable Discharge. Jack married Mary Lou Moody on November 5th, 1948 in Gainesville, Texas and she preceded him in death in 2013. He retired from the MPI Company in Oklahoma City where he worked as a Materials Handler. He was very crafty and loved making rockers out of clothes pins and distributing them to almost everyone he came in contact with. It gave him great joy to share them. Jack was a man of few words, but very dedicated to his family.

Ron Hallmark, five brothers, Arlin, Herman, Jim, Joe, and Elbert "Runt" Hallmark and two sisters, Melba Barnett and Pauline Wilson.
