



## Jack Gordon Wood

Jack Gordon Wood, a resident of Sulphur, was born December 17, 1916 in Depew to Dana & Annice Olivia "Clark" Wood. He passed away Saturday, February 14, 2004 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 87 years. He was married to Mildred Elsie (Clarkson) Wood at the First Baptist Church in Nowata, Oklahoma on April 06, 1936. He grew up around Nowata and graduated from Lenapah High School. He lived in several states before moving back to Oklahoma where he resided in Lindsay, Oklahoma City, and finally to Sulphur in 2002. Mr. Wood retired from Western Company North America in 1982. He was a member of the Delaware Indian Tribe and was extremely proud of his Delaware Heritage. He was a Veteran of WWII where he served in the US Army. He was a member of Shields Blvd. Baptist Church in Oklahoma City and also a member of the American Legion.

Mr. Wood was the last survivor of his immediate family. He was preceded in death by his parents; a son, Jimmy Gordon Wood; a granddaughter, Robin Renee Reid; a grandson, Joshua Lee Wood; 4 brothers; and 1 sister. He is survived by his wife; two daughters, Delores Reid and Betty Israel; one son, Buddy Wood and his wife Karen; 11 grandchildren; 11 great grandchildren; 1 great great grandchild; and numerous neices and nephews.
