Jack E. Mathis, a resident of Sulphur was born June 14, 1923 in Detroit, Texas to Janett (Morgan) and Jack R. Mathis. He passed away Friday May 2, 2008 at Ardmore, Oklahoma at the age of 84 years 10 months and 18 days. Jack lived his early life in Texas.
