Funeral Services for Mr. James H. "Jim" Jameson, 73, of Kaufman, Texas will be held on Saturday, January 17th, 2015 at 1:00 p. m. in the Herb Clark Memorial Chapel in Tishomingo, Oklahoma with Rev. Mr. Jameson passed away on January 13th, 2015 at his home.

Jim was born on July 7th, 1941 in Ballinger, Texas to William T. Jameson and Eula Grace (Summers) Jameson. He graduated from Newmon High School in Sweetwater, Texas and later served in the United States Air Force during the Vietnam conflict, from which he was Honorably discharged. Jim met and married Mary Kathryn Vestal on March 10th, 1975 in Dallas, Texas. He retired from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company where he worked as a Data Engineer for 35 years. After retirement, they moved to Ardmore, Oklahoma and he worked in maintenance for the First Presbyterian Church and the Emmanuel Baptist Church. In 2010, they relocated back to the Dallas/Ft. Worth area. Jim loved the Lord and Southern Gospel music. Gaye Gastineau and her family were very gracious and allowed him to film their concerts and share the tapes with churches and shut- ins.
