



## James M. 'Red' Tucker

Funeral Services for Mr. James M. "Red" Tucker, 80, of Reagan, Oklahoma will be held on Friday, June 20th, 2014 at 2:00 p. m. at the Condon Grove Cemetery in Milburn, Oklahoma with Rev. Kenneth McCarthick officiating. Mr. Tucker passed away on June 16th, 2014 at his home.

James M. "Red" Tucker was born on May 29, 1934 in Alderson, Oklahoma to Jim Tucker and Willie (Sweeten) Tucker. He graduated from high school in Guymon, Oklahoma and later served in the United States Army from 1953 until 1956 as a Paratrooper in the 101st Airborne Division. After being Honorably Discharged, Red worked in the tire business in Oklahoma City and Dallas, Texas for several years and came to Johnson County in the early 1980's. He purchased the store in Ravia, Oklahoma which became known as Big Red's and on April 3rd, 1993 he married Clarice Boyd in Gainesville, Texas. They operated the store until selling it and retiring in 2005.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Lewis and a sister, Jean.

Red is survived by his wife Clarice, of the home, sons, Mike Sharrock of Rockwall County, Texas, Bobby Sharrock of Reagan, Oklahoma, Chris Martin and Todd Martin of Norman, Oklahoma, daughter Tracy Martin, also of Norman, two sisters, Pat Schillace of Antioch, California and Jeri McClendon of Bay Point, California, nine grandchildren to include, Shoal & Shea Sharrock and Christina Etheridge, and one great-grandchild.
