August 27, 1935 - March 20, 2025

Jeraldine “Jeri” Anderson, age 89, of Tishomingo, Oklahoma, passed away on Thursday, March 20, 2025, at Texoma Medical Center in Denison, Texas. Jeri was born on August 27, 1935, in the Bullard Chapel community to NR Bynum and Hattie Brownlee Bynum.

She grew up in the Tishomingo area, attending Prairie View and Tishomingo schools. Jeri married the love of her life, Bobby Joe Anderson, on November 22, 1959, in Durant, Oklahoma, and together they raised a loving family.
