Jerri Marie Bruton, a resident of Sulphur, Oklahoma was born February 15, 1922 in Dougherty, Oklahoma to Valla E. (White) and Walter Jack. She passed away Sunday December 30, 2007 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 85 years 10 months and 15 days.

She grew up in Dougherty, attending school in Dougherty and Ardmore, graduating from Ardmore High School in 1940. She then went on to the University of Oklahoma where she graduated in 1945 with a Bachelor's degree in Speech Therapy. she was married to Joseph Douglas Bruton at Sulphur, Oklahoma on July 29, 1944. She taught in the School of Education at OU, was the co-founder of the School of Listening Eyes in Wichita Falls, Texas, taught speech therapy in Sulphur Schools. She gave private speech lessons and held public seminars at OU. She also had articles published in National Education Publications. She was also former President of the Sulphur Chamber of Commerce, Chairman of Murray County Bi-Centennial Celebration, and active in the Democratic Party. She was a member of First Pentecostal Holiness Church of Sulphur, Oklahoma where she has lived since 1961. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband - Joseph Douglas on July 29, 1972, and brothers Tom and Bill Jack.
