Jim Stark, a resident of Wynnewood was born March 31, 1947 in Red Oak, Oklahoma to Bertie O. (Tomlinson) and William P. Stark. He passed away June 22, 2012 at the age of 65 years 2 months and 21 days. He was married to Linda Carrell (Hollie) Stark at the Red Oak Church of Christ on September 2, 1967, she preceded him in death on April 5, 2011. He had achieved his Master's in Education from the University of Oklahoma.
