Jimmie D. Teters, a resident of Sulphur was born October 9, 1927 in Wapanucka, Oklahoma to Jimmie & Alice (Tyree) Teters. He passed away Monday March 1, 2010 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 82 years 4 months and 22 days. Jimmie grew up in the Ada area; graduating from Byng High School. After high school he served in the army during WWII for 2 years. After the military he returned to Stratford where he began his banking career at the Okla. State Bank in 1946. Jimmie and Wanda Turner were married in 1949 in Ada and she preceded him in death in 2002. In 1966, he was president and Chairman of the Board at First National Bank in Stratford which later became First American Bank. While in Stratford, Jimmie served as Mayor from 1974 to 1986. He was a member of Ada Kiwanis where he made many cherished friends and Stratford Booster Club. In 1987, Jimmie went to work at First Heritage Bank/ now Landmark Bank in Wynnewood. He later transferred to Davis where he retired in Dec. 2000. Jimmie moved to Sulphur in 1995 to be closer to the golf course. Jimmie & Wanda Stinson were married on Jan. 14, 2003 in Sulphur. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Sulphur. He was also preceded in death by his parents; 3 brothers and 1 sister.
