Funeral Services for Mrs. Jimmie Lou Faught, 78, of Tishomingo, Oklahoma will be held on Tuesday, January 22nd, 2013 at 2:00 p. m. in the Clark Funeral Chapel with Rev. Jon Hazell officiating.
