



Jimmy Kenneth 'Jim' Lowry

September 11, 1940 - March 15, 2015

Jimmy Kenneth Lowry of Tishomingo, OK, died unexpectedly following a stroke at the age of 74 on Sunday March 15th, 2015 in Denison, TX.

Jim is survived by his wife, Linda Lowry, grandchildren Nathan and Shelby Lowry and great grandson Jackson McDaniel.

Jim was born on September 11, 1940 in Dallas, TX. He is preceded in death by his mother and father, Kenneth and Juanita Lowry, and also by his son, Scott Lowry, who lost his life suddenly last November.

Jim's career got off to an early start as he spent long days harvesting wheat with his father and grandfather anywhere from Texas to Montana, a vocation he would later share with his son, Scott. Jim would later earn his living as a professional driver hauling oversized loads, including parts of the spaceship and other massive equipment. Jim was an expert at what he did and he possessed a rare skill as a man who could drive anything and do so with unmatched precision. Jim retired to Tishomingo, where he and Scott would run cattle on the property that drew its origin as a dairy farm in the family of his wife Linda. Jim took great pride in embracing his role as a rancher.

Jim was a gentle and caring man, a loving husband, father, grandfather and more recently great grandfather. A man of few words, Jim was never shy

when it came to bragging about his grandchildren; Nathan – a doctor at Baylor Scott and White, and Shelby – a stellar student at Texas A&M and loving mother to her son Jackson. Jim derived great joy from the outdoors and from working with his hands. He was a firearm enthusiast and expert marksman. He will be deeply missed by his friends, family and all of those who had the privilege of knowing him.

Visitation for family and friends will take place Wednesday night from 6 to 8 o'clock in the evening at Clark's Funeral Home in Tishomingo. Services are scheduled for 11 o'clock in the morning on Thursday in Clark's Funeral Home Chapel. Rev. Kenneth McCarthick officiating.
