February 16, 1917 - November 4, 2011

Joe C. McDaniel, a resident of Sulphur was born February 16, 1917 in Stanford, Texas to Joe Clark & Ruth (Swan) McDaniel. He passed away Friday November 4, 2011 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 94 years 8 months and 18 days. He grew up in Sulphur where he graduated from Sulphur High School. He was a graduate of Okla. A & M where he was on the wrestling team. He served as assistant wrestling coach at Okla. A&M during Ed Gallaghers last year. He was later head coach at Maryland for 1 year, Syracuse for 10 years, Wyoming for 11 years, and Sulphur High School for 11 years. He was inducted into the OSU Wrestlers Hall of Honor, and the National Wrestling Hall of Fame. Joe and Virginia Dale Hamilton were married on August 14, 1962 in Farmington, New Mexico. He was a veteran of WWII serving in the US Army.

He was preceded in death by his parents, 1 sister: Fern Washburn; 1 brother: Paul McDaniel and a nephew: Dr. William McDaniel.
